How to use this resource:

Use the **T.A.L.E.N.T.S**. acronym sheet to help your child discover and develop his or her talents.

T is for think - Think about things you're good at.

A is for ask - Ask others what they think your talents are.

L is for look - Look for ways you can use your talents.

E is for enjoy - Enjoy your talents.

N is for nurture - Nurture your talent by practicing.

T is for thank God - Thank God for the talent He gave you.

S is for share - Share your talent with others

Use the brainstorm map to write down ways your child can grow their talents. For example, in the *think* box, write the things your child thinks her or she is good at. In the *ask* box, write the things others say your child is good at. Once your child has decided which talents they want to develop, write them in the center box.
